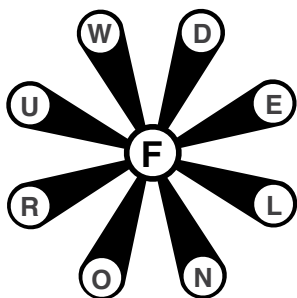
Work out all the missing parts of these cities and countries from around the world and find the words hidden in the box of letters. The letters left over will spell out some major cities.

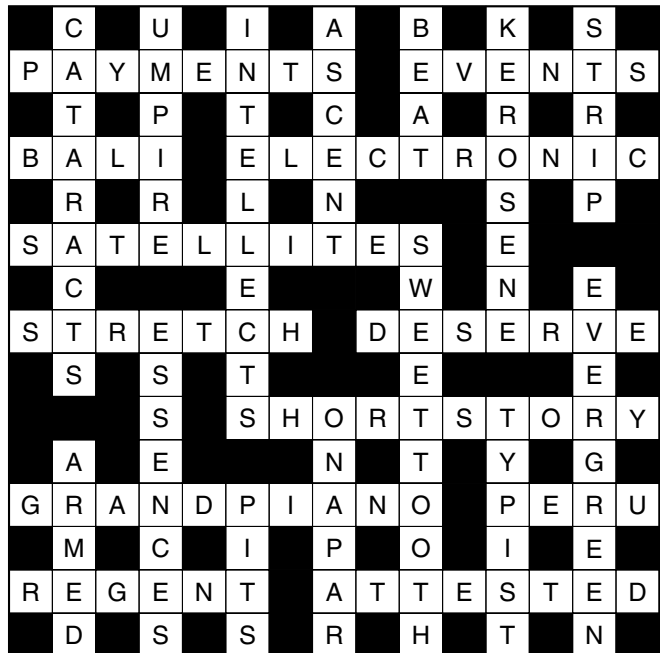
